Dear Taxpayer:


Please find enclosed a separate property tax statement for annual sewer services. Normally, the sewer service assessment is consolidated with other property taxes, charges, and assessments in a single tax statement from the Alameda County Tax Collector. You are one of approximately 17,000 Livermore property owners who received a property tax statement from the Tax Collector that inadvertently did not include the annual sewer service assessment. This is not a new charge; it was just omitted from the statement you originally received. The enclosed separate property tax statement together with the original tax statement, includes the required charges.

Your property tax payments are still due by the delinquent dates of December 10, 2021 (first installment) and April 11, 2022 (second installment) including for this separate statement. If you have an impound account, where your lender pays your property taxes, we will send them a revised file that includes the total amount due. If your original tax statement has already been paid, you will need to pay the amount on the enclosed property tax statement.

We want to sincerely apologize for any confusion from the separate tax statements. We have taken every measure to make sure that in the future, the Tax Collector's annual property tax statement includes all property taxes, charges, and assessments.
