A MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR



The IRS has announced changes to the annual maximum deferral amounts for the 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan for 2024.

New deferral amounts are as follows:

Regular Maximum (age 49 and younger)	Minimum Bi-Weekly Amount (26 pay periods)
\$23,000.00	\$884.62
Catch-Up (age 50+)	Minimum Bi-Weekly Amount (26 pay periods)
\$30,500	\$1.173.08
3-Year Special Catch Up*	Minimum Bi-Weekly Amount (26 pay periods)
\$46,000	To Be Determined, individually calculated

Please note, if your current bi-weekly amount is not changed, it shall continue into 2024 until a change is submitted; refer to hyperlink above.

Age 50: If you become age 50 in any month of 2024, you may begin deferring the 'Catch-Up' amount beginning pay period 1 of January 2024.

Roth Feature: If you make Roth contributions before December 31, 2024, the 5 taxable-year period of participation will be counted as beginning on January 1, 2024.
